

## **ROAD INFORMATION**

**Residents are reminded that it is unlawful under Minnesota Statute 160.2715 to obstruct any road or deposit snow or ice thereon. Piles of snow left on or near the road can freeze into a solid mass creating a hazardous situation for vehicles and snowplows. Piles of snow increase the chance of drifting snow onto the roadway.**

**The Kandiyohi County Zoning Ordinance requires a setback of 75 feet or more from road right of way for bales and stacks of hay, straw, cornstalks or the like from November 1 to April 1. The purpose of the setback is to keep unnecessary snow drifts from forming and eliminate extra snow plowing costs caused by bale induced snow drifts.**
